- Complete required reading per syllabi available at wjbrooksdo.com/seminars prior to each session.
- Both sessions will be recorded. While the focus of recording will be on Dr Brooks, each participant must sign an audiovisual release conferring permission to Dr. Brooks to use the AV recordings for further education, promotion, and seminar development at his professional discretion.
- Provide a brief medical history as to possible contraindications to any or all OMM techniques, which will be confidentially archived in accordance with HIPPA standards by Dr Brooks.
- Attendance at BOTH sessions A. August 15 – 18 and B. September 12 – 15, 2024 in Tucson, AZ. Travel funds will be awarded *only* after attending both sessions unless health or family emergencies occur. Travel expense receipts may be required.
- Be interested in and available to table train at a future IFPMSS seminar as well as participate in future reliability research. One seminar in 2025 is anticipated for the physician audience. Table trainers at future seminars will be reimbursed for travel expenses and paid honoraria commensurate with the going rate for table trainers. Reimbursement for participation in future research at a time TBD will be contingent upon research funding.
